Certificate database of DGUV Test: function and search options

<u>DGUV Test's Certificate database</u> is a practical tool for selecting safe products. It can be used to search online for products bearing a valid certificate from one of the testing and certification bodies in DGUV Test.

Users of the database have access to information on over 19,500 certificates. By purchasing products tested by testing and certification bodies in DGUV Test, companies can be confident that the products are perfectly safe. The Certificate database is also useful to market surveillance bodies and the retail trade, as it enables them to check the validity of certificates quickly and easily. (Note: We have no information on certificates issued by testing and certification bodies outside DGUV Test.).

Please use the certificate number to check whether a certificate is genuine, or whether your product's certificate is available online?

► Call up the search dialog on the homepage of the Certificate database and enter the certificate number in the relevant field.

Would you like to know which testing and certification body in DGUV Test is responsible for testing and certifying your product?

Follow the link to Fields of activity (in the menu at the top of the homepage of the Certificate database). This takes you to a search dialog in which you can filter by the product areas and fields of activity of DGUV Test's testing and certification bodies.

Do you wish to purchase a particular product and would like to be certain that it has been tested and certified?

- "Entries A-Z" calls up an index of the tested products. You can search here alphabetically for specific products.
- The DGUV Test website has a further option for searching for selected tested and certified products. A drop-down menu takes you directly to the manufacturers who possess a relevant certificate for their product.

The following information is displayed for a certificate:

Product designation, certificate number, certificate type (e. g. GS certificate, EC/EU type examination certificate).

Where a certificate provides information on the product's type and use, this information is also displayed. To call up this information, click on the symbol above the search results:

(i) More Information

The certificate holder's address is stated for each product. In some cases, a link to the certificate holder's website is also provided. You can therefore request further information from the certificate holder, for example on where you can procure the product.
