Workshop Tidiness and Safety

Important requirements before entering

- 1. Only enter workshops and machine rooms under the supervision of the instructor.
- 2. Wear appropriate, close-fitting clothing.
- 3. Tie back long hair.
- 4. Be aware of escape routes and firefighting facilities and keep them clear at all times.
- 5. Only work with machines after receiving instructions from the instructor.

Before you start work ...

- 1. Create a safe workspace with freedom of movement at a workstation or machine.
- 2. Ensure tools and equipment are in proper working order.
- 3. Tell the instructor immediately if you find any damaged tools, defects or other hazards.
- 4. Read and follow all work instructions. If there is anything you don't understand, ask the instructor before you start working.
- 5. Securely clamp materials and workpieces before you start working with the
- 6. Use designated protective gear for hazardous jobs
- 7. (e.g. protective goggles, earmuffs).

When you've finished working...

- 1. Clean tools and equipment.
- 2. Tidy up workstations: use a suitable vacuum cleaner for large amounts of wood dust, and pick up any residual material that has fallen on the ground.
- 3. Store tools, equipment and materials in designated locations.
- 4. Store work clothing and wash hands.
- 5. Ventilate the room.
